Getting to Portsmouth by car

Portsmouth enjoys good road connections; the A3 (M) puts London only 90 minutes away and the M275, which comes right into the heart of the city centre, connects Portsmouth with the M27 and the rest of Britain's motorway network.

There is plenty of parking in the city and once here it is easy to get around on foot.

48 hours in Portsmouth





Day one

Start your trip with a walk along the Renaissance Trail and take in the sights of the city. The trail follows a chain motif set in the pavement along the Millennium Promenade from Old Portsmouth and information panels provide glimpses into the history of the area along the way.

Take a breather from all that walking and visit the iconic Spinnaker Tower – it's a great introduction to the city. Soaring 170m high and standing proudly over Portsmouth, it's the tallest viewing tower in Britain. Experience a real 'wow factor' from the three viewing decks as the floor-toceiling glass windows provide breathtaking views stretching up to 23 miles, giving visitors a unique perspective of the city and surrounding area. See historic ships, look out over the Solent to see the Isle of Wight and watch as famous naval ships come into port.

Whilst at Gunwharf Quays pay a visit to Aspex contemporary art gallery. Presenting an outstanding exhibition programme featuring work by contemporary artist from around the world, Aspex is also a great place to see Portsmouth's freshest artistic talent.

Enjoy an early supper before taking in a show at The Kings Theatre or the New Theatre Royal.

Day two

On day two visit Portsmouth Historic Dockyard, a unique attraction showcasing 800 years of naval history within working docks and historic buildings.

Give yourself the whole day to experience the site in full – there's so much to see. Explore world-famous historic ships HMS Victory and HMS Warrior 1860. Visit the National Museum of the Royal Navy and the Mary Rose Museum, complete with hundreds of artefacts and original finds. Get interactive at Action Stations and take a Harbour Tour to view the great naval warships in port. Break up your day with a bite to eat at Boathouse No.7 or the Georgian Tearooms.

Spend a relaxed evening in Southsea where you'll find a selection of stylish café bars, wine bars and distinctive restaurants.
