Day 1

On the way to your hotel in the Aylesbury area, we've lined up a refreshing cuppa and cakes after a stroll around the award winning gardens and renowned herbaceous borders at Waterperry Gardens, formerly a School of Horticulture for Ladies. Overnight in Aylesbury for 2 nights.



Day 2

Today will concentrate largely on Alice in Wonderland and Lewis Carroll's close association with the university city of Oxford. Your journey of discovery will start at the Museum of Oxford where you will see the unique collection of Alice Liddell's personal belongings and find out about what lies behind the 'Alice' stories. On then to Christ Church college where more of Alice's Adventures (and something on Harry Potter) will be brought to life during your special tour. Allowing time for lunch, we'll also include a visit to the Christ Church Picture Gallery where you'll see an important collection of Old Master paintings and drawings. The rest of the afternoon will be spent following a literary trail where the spotlight will shine mainly on locations associated with Inspector Morse.

Day 3

Picking up on yesterday's literary theme, you are invited to spend an hour or so at the fantabulous interactive Roald Dahl Museum and Story telling Centre. From here it is only a short hop for a fascinating nostalgic look at yesteryear at the Chiltern Open Air Museum where you'll experience rural life among the homes and workplaces of past generations. To finish the day, you'll take a ride on a steam train at the Buckinghamshire Railway Centre which is home to some 30 locomotives, carriages and waggons from Victorian England to the 1960s. return to your hotel for a second night.

Day 4

Before returning home, we've arranged an out of hours, before the doors open visit to the outstanding Waddesdon Manor which was built during the 19th century for Baron Ferdinand de Rothschild to display his outstanding collection of art treasures. Before leaving, you'll have time to wander in the Victorian gardens, considered by many to be some of the finest in Britain.
