

Discover a 158 acre wonderland which features mystical follies, historic plantings and the John Bartram Heritage Collection of North American trees and shrubs (Plant Heritage, NCCPG). Learn about the Honourable Charles Hamilton who created Painshill by booking a Historic Tour of the beautiful 18th century landscape and the newly restored crystal Grotto.

Painshill welcomes pre-booked group visits throughout the year. A range of pre-booked guided tours which include visits to other local historic attractions such as Strawberry Hill House, Brooklands Museum and Denbies Wine Estate are also available on selected days. Painshill has a tea room (lunches and refreshments can be pre-booked), gift shop and free coach parking accessible routes, free buggy hire (maximum of 5 disabled persons and free wheelchair hire.

Guildford—Directions

Guildford is the county town of Surrey, England and the seat for the borough of Guildford. It is situated 27 miles southwest of London on the A3 trunk road mid-way between the capital and Portsmouth.

Road Directions

Guildford has excellent road links to London (40 minutes) and the South Coast (50 minutes) and is served by M25, M3 and A3.

By rail

Guildford Town has excellent rail links to Central London (35 minutes) and Portsmouth (55 minutes) as well as a direct rail link to Gatwick Airport. Trains from Guildford to London terminate at Waterloo Station.
